THE 10 POINT CHECKLIST TO TEACHING YOUR CHILD AN AGE-APPROPRIATE CURRICULUM

01	For the next 3 months, come what may, commit to Assuming Intelligence in your student 100%	<input type="checkbox"/>
02	While choosing what to teach, teach 10% higher than age-appropriate level	<input type="checkbox"/>
03	Teach for 10-15 mins at a time 1-3 times a day.	<input type="checkbox"/>
04	Stop when the child is dysregulated or in fight-or-flight.	<input type="checkbox"/>

06	Don't test for the first 3 months	<input type="checkbox"/>
07	<p>Start working toward teaching your child an appropriate means of complex communication (preferably using a letterboard based technique).</p> <p>I recommend one of the following if your child has unreliable speech:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <u>RPM</u> 2. <u>S2C</u> 3. <u>Spellers Method</u> 	<input type="checkbox"/>

08	Do not teach any topic for more than 1 month.	<input type="checkbox"/>
09	Do not teach any topic without variation	<input type="checkbox"/>
10	If you are bored, don't teach.	<input type="checkbox"/>
